Chief Engineer or Additional Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers of all Circles and Executive Engineers/Assistant Engineer of all divisions under Municipal Engineering Directorate, West Bengal are accordingly delegated technical sanction and tender acceptance power as above for execution of any kind of development work /project assigned to them by the Urban Local Body or by the State Government Department. All the projects beyond Rs. 4 crore will be placed in the State Level Technical Committee constituted by the administrative Department as per guidelines under different State /Central schemes.

Urban Local Bodies may assign execution of any project to Municipal Engineering Directorate by resolution and Superintendent Engineer of Circle and Executive Engineers in Divisions shall be responsible for timely execution of projects/schemes, supervision and monitoring over Urban Local Bodies in their jurisdiction.
- 4. This order issues with the approval of competent authority of UD & MA Department and in concurrence with Finance Department vide their UO No. Group/R/2017-2018/0048 dated 01/06/2017 and takes with immediate effect.
