I am directed to refer to your g-mail dated 18.01.2016 and 28.01.2016 on the subject noted above and to inform that an amount of Rs.320.00 crore towards outstanding dues as on 31.12.2015 in respect of Rs.307.14 crore for Kolkata Municipal Corporation and Rs.12.86 crore for Howrah Municipal Corporation and an amount of Rs. 28,97,13,871/- only towards outstanding dues in respect of remaining 25 ULBs have since been released vide this Department's Memo. Nos. 440 (Sanction) & 441 (Sanction) both dated 21.03.2016 respectively (copies enclosed), directing therein the Director, State Urban Development Agency to issue cheques accordingly in favour of CESC Limited.
