Whereas Barjora Gangajalghati Planning Authority (hereinafter called 'B.G.P.A.'), in pursuance of the provisions of Section 40 of the West Bengal Town and Country (Planning and Development) Act, 1979 (West Bengal Act XIII of 1979) has prepared an Amendment of Land Use and Development Control Plan with respect to Plot No.: 3188 (L.R.), Mouza: Kishoripur, J.L. No.: 19, G.P.: Ghutgoria, Block: Barjora under Barjora Gangajalghati Planning Authority.

And now therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (I) of Section 36 of the said Act, B.G.P.A. hereby publishes the Public Notice of the preparation of the amendment of the LUDCP with respect to the said plot, as directed by the State Government vide No.: 1541-UDMA-22013(13)/2/2021-DAC SEC-Dept. of UDMA-Part (I) dated: 09.09.2024, inviting objections in writing from any person with respect to the said plot within a period of 60 (sixty) days (from the date of publication of this public notice in The Kolkata Gazette Extraordinary).

1. Introduction to Planning Area

Barjora Gangajalghati Planning Area is located at the northern part of the Bankura District, in close proximity to the Durgapur Asansol Industrial Region, just separated by the Damodar river, flowing from East to West. The planning area has become very important considering the natural resources of coal, iron and steel related industries located in Durgapur, Raniganj and Mejla which are in close propinquity to this Planning area. Besides, there is significant sal forest covers in the southern mouzas of planning area (Gangajalghati protected forest & Bellatore protected forest).

The West Bengal Town & Country (Planning & Development) Act, 1979 has been operating within the whole state of West Bengal, except in the area that comes under the Cantonment Act, 1924 since 1979, with an objective to promote planned development in both rural and urban areas.

On the 21stday of September 1992, the West Bengal Town & Country (Planning & Development) Act, 1979 had come into force in 44 mouzas under Barjora Police Station and 38 mouzas under Gangajalghati Police Station under Sadar Subdivision of District Bankura vide the notification no. 2990-T&CP/1S-3/91. It covers an area of 197.92 sq. km. with a population of 1,19,826 as per 2011 census.

On the same date this area was declared as planning area in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-section 1 and Sub-section-2 of Section 9 of the said Act vide notification no.2991-T&CP/1S-3/91and the District Magistrate of Bankura was declared as the Planning Authority vide notification no. 2992-T&CP/1S-3/91 dated 21.09.1992.

With the technical consultation of the experts of the Town & Country Planning Branch of the erstwhile Urban Development Department, Government of West Bengal, the District Authority, with the support of concerned blocks, prepared the Land Use Map and Land Register(LUMR)of the entire planning area under Section 28 of the WBT&C (P&D), Act,1979 and in compliance of the directives in Section 29 of the said Act, the LUMR was published in the Official Gazette on 3rd December, 2002 vide notification no. 757/DPC dated 31.10.2002.

On the basis of the available secondary information and primary survey data generated by the officials of concerned Blocks, District Planning Office and the experts of Town & Country Planning Branch of Urban Development Department, the Land Use and Development Control Plan (LUDCP) was prepared under Section 31 of the said Act to achieve planned homogeneous development of Barjora Gangajalghati Planning Area with an objective to provide adequate infrastructures and facilities for decent living without jeopardising the ecological balance of the region by imposing certain restrictions to control the haphazard growth. The LUDCP was adopted and published in the Official Gazette under Section 38 of the said Act on 3rd August, 2012 vide notification no. 12/BGPA dated 14.06.2012.

The LUDCP is primarily a planning document to guide future development of any notified planning area by formulating pragmatic planning policies in respect of development by imposing rational control on the general uses of land and by allocating suitable location to accommodate future activities.

2. Background for Amendment of the LUDCP

The Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) which is a Government of India undertaking Maharatna Oil &Gas company, under the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Government of India, responsible for supplying and distributing petroleum products across India, has been awarded the authorisation for laying, building, operating & expanding the City Gas Distribution Network (CGD Network) in the geographical areas of Purulia & Bankura districts of West Bengal by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) under the PNGRB Act, 2006.

This project is of National importance and being monitored by PNGRB. Natural Gas and Compressed Natural gas (CNG) offers environment friendly fuel options. CGD network comprises network of Steel & MDPE pipelines for transmission of Natural Gas to various customers in the domestic, commercial transport, and industrial segments.

For providing Natural Gas in the Bankura CGD network, BPCL has made plans to take tap-off from the existing GAIL SV-33 situated on the DDHPL (Dhamra Durgapur Haldia Pipeline) in Kadasol village, Kishoripore Mouza, BarjoraBlock, Bankura district, through steel pipelines and MDPE pipelines.

To establish BPCL's City Gas station (CGS) near the above GAIL SV-33, the construction of City Gas Station on the said chunk of land having plot no. 3188(LR), in Mouza Kishoripore, JL no. 19, under Ghutgoriagram panchayat in Barjora Block is very much essential in public interest, because of its low emission rates and other eco-friendly benefits.

3. Present land Use of the plot under consideration

As per the notified copy of the LUMR of BGPA area, published under section 29 (5) of the WB T&C (P&D), Act, 1979, the present land use of the plot under consideration is agricultural. As per the current LUDCP published vide notification no. 12/BGPA dated 14.06.2012, the said plot falls on Mining Zone.

4. Proposed land Use for the plot under consideration

For the project of BPCL to become feasible, opinion of the Department of Industry, Commerce and Enterprises (I&CE Deptt.) of Government of West Bengal was sought in this regard.

Department of Industry, Commerce and Enterprises, Government of West Bengal stated that the specific plot (plot no. 3188 of mouza Kishoripur, J.L. No. 19, P.S. & Block Barjora) does not fall within any operative/allotted/un-allotted coal block, and also a letter in this respect has been received from the Additional Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, U.D. & M.A. Department, Town & Country Planning Branch, Kolkata-700064 vide No.: 1335-22013(13)/2/2021-DAC SEC-Dept. of UDMA-Part(2) Dated the Kolkata, 9th August, 2024. It is located more or less 55 metres South of the southern boundary line of "Mohanpur Sector" coal block (un-alloted) of Raniganj Coalfield (alongside the Nutangram—Barjora Road), which was regionally explored by Geological Survey of India (GSI). The Mohanpur Sector Coal Block is adjacent to the Trans-Damodar Coal Block (on its West), which is being mined by DPL at present. There is very rare possibility of existence of any significant mineable coal seam as well as any non-coal minerals underneath the specific plot and its close vicinity. As per records, there is no mining lease for any mineral in Kishoripur mouza.

In view of what have been stated above, I&CE Department, GoWB further opined that the specific plot may be utilized for setting up of a CNG filling Station by BPCL after conversion of land use status.

Based on the opinion of Department of Industry, Commerce and Enterprises, the amendment of the LUDCP for BGPA for the said plot is essential for setting up a CNG filling station in the planning area in public interest.

Therefore, the proposed land use for the plot no 3188 (LR), village Kadasol, Mouza Kishoripore, (J.L No. 19),G.P- Ghutgoria, Block Barjora, will be Commercial.


5. Calculation of Development Charge


