WHEREAS in terms of provisions of sub-section (2) of section 14 of the West Bengal Municipal Act, 1993 (West Ben. Act XXII of 1993) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act) the Board of Councillors, unless dissolved earlier, shall hold office for a period of five years from the date appointed for its first meeting after the general election and no longer;

AND WHEREAS the first meeting of the Board of Councillors of Nalhati Municipality in the district of Birbhum, after the last Municipal General Election to the said Municipality, was held on the 15th June, 2012, and the term of the Board of Councillors of Nalhati Municipality shall expire on the 14th June, 2017;

AND WHEREAS it is not possible to hold the general election to the said Municipality before the expiry of the period of five years specified in sub section (2) of section 14 of the said Act and in terms of provisions of sub-section (4) of section 14 of the said Act the Board of Councillors of the said Municipality shall stand dissolved after expiry of its term on the 14th June, 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (4) of section 14 of the said Act, the Governor is pleased hereby to appoint the Sub-divisional Officer, Rampurhat as the Administrator of Nalhati Municipality with effect from the 15th June, 2017, till the new Board of Councillors of the said Municipality takes over charge after the elections to be held or until further orders, whichever is earlier:
