**Dated, Kolkata, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020**

WHEREAS water resources are gradually being depleted due to adverse changes in climatic conditions, scanty and erratic rainfall, increasing industrialization, population growth, ground water extortion, increasing demand for domestic and agricultural purposes;

AND WHEREAS it is need of the hour to prevent the depletion of water, to increase the supply of usable water, to maximize the collection and treatment of generated sewage, reuse of treated waste water on a sustainable basis and thereby reducing dependency on fresh water resources;

AND WHEREAS the State Government has constituted a Committee vide Notification no.37-JS(SM)/UD&MA/2019 dated 16.04.2019 (hereinafter referred to as the said Committee) comprising of the officials from the Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs, the State Urban Development Agency (SUDA), the Institute of Local Government & Urban Studies (ILGUS), the Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) and the West Bengal Pollution Control Board (WBPCB) for preparation of a Comprehensive Policy on Treated Wastewater Re-use Policy of Urban West Bengal (hereinafter referred to as the said Comprehensive Policy);

NOW THEREFORE as per recommendation of the said Committee, the said Comprehensive Policy is hereby adopted with immediate effect to give focus on strategy plan for recycling of water through appropriate centralized or decentralized technology intervention and execution thereof in time bound manner as well as extensive public awareness activities in the cities of West Bengal.
