A BRIEF NOTE ON THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE GOVERNMENT DURING 2021

An update on the achievements in various sectors during 2021 is given below:

Finance

- Successfully completed e-Stamping module with NeSL (National e-Governance Services Limited) for digital document execution of Bank loan documents, etc.
- Received SKOCH AWARD (GOVERNANCE- SILVER), 2021 for e-Nathikaran system e-Preparation and e-Submission of deeds.
- All Treasury linked branches of State Bank of India have been brought under digitised cheque clearing system.

Home and Hill Affairs:

- West Bengal Police Housing Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (WBPHIDCL) completed 26 new police infrastructure projects, including 4 Model Police Station buildings, 6 Barracks, 64 Lower Subordinate/ Upper Subordinate quarters and a 500-capacity hostel building for lady trainees at Swami Vivekananda State Police Academy, Barrackpore.
- Construction of Composite Bus Terminus at Dinhata completed. Construction of permanent Rehabiliation Housing at Dinhata completed.

Industry, Commerce & Enterprises

- 'Jangal Sundari Karmanagari' has been launched.
- Pharmaceutical Park at Falta over 100 acres was delineated and published by WBIIDC.
- An information booklet on few industries (156 nos.) in Bengal titled, 'Industries in Bengal A Glimpse' was published by WBIDC with inputs from industrial units in Bengal.
- Three New Policies have been introduced viz. West Bengal Ethanol Production Promotion Policy, 2021; West Bengal Sand Mining Policy, 2021; Data Center Policy, 2021.

Roads and Bridges

- PWD completed the construction of 4-Lane JAI HIND Bridge (ROB) adjacent to Majherhat Railway Station at 5.80 km on Diamond Harbour Road at a cost of Rs. 311.76 crore within a remarkable period of 1 year 11 months applying new technology.
- Construction of Long Span High Level JOYEE Bridge over river Teesta with approaches near Haldibari connecting Sub-divisional Head Quarter at Mekhliganj with Per-Mekhliganj/Haldibari in the district of Coochbehar has been completed. This bridge reduces the distance between these two towns by 75 km.
- Construction of Road over Bridge (R.O.B) & Approach Ramps at Fulbari Gazoldoba Canal Road in Lieu of Unauthorised Level Crossing of Track At KM 4/9-5/0 under Kathihar Division of Northeast Frontier Railways (Except R.O.B proper) in the district of Jalpaiguri completed.
- Pedestrian Underpass by Box Jacking Technique at Laketown Crossing of K.N.I. Avenue in the district of North 24 Parganas has been constructed.

Information Technology

- Construction of Webel Tower-I Project (BN-4), Webel Tower-I Project (BN-9), Webel IT Park (Ph-II) and Webel IT Park (Ph-II) Project at Kalyani completed.
- Completion of cyber security training center set up at Asansol, Barjora, Purulia & Siliguri (Ph-II) IT Parks
- Connectivity between WBSDC and WBSWAN has been upgraded from 1 Gbps to 10 Gbps to meet up increased bandwidth demand through WBSWAN.
- Cyber Security Centre of Excellence of this Department received 2nd Elets India Transformation Summit & Award for the project 'CYBER SAFE BENGAL, CYBER SAFE INDIA' under the category Cyber Security Initiative.

- Cyber Security Centre of Excellence of this Department received the Indian Express Digital Technology Sabha Award 2021 under Enterprise Security category.
- Shri Sanjay Kumar Das, WBCS(Exe.), Joint Secretary, IT&E Department, Govt. of West Bengal and Member-Secretary, CS-CoE received the Elite Excellence Awards-2020.

Power

- 5.82 lacs new consumers added to reach consumer base as 2.11 Crore.
- 10 nos. new 33/11 KV Sub-station commissioned.
- New 33 KV System commissioned at Howrah 220 KV Substation for Metro Rail Connectivity.
- 132/33 KV Substation namely Burdwan 132 GIS (Purba Burdwan) commissioned with capacity addition of 150 MVA.
- One 220 KV transmission line (58 circuit KM) & 9 nos. 132 KV transmission lines (378 circuit KM) commissioned with total addition to the system being 436 circuit KM.
- 132 kV D/C Transmission line from Moinaguri 132kV Substation to Mathabhanga 132kV Substation commissioned.
- WBPDCL achieved highest ever generation 23,874.24 MU in FY 2020-21 and crossed earlier high of 23,853.39 MU which was achieved in FY 2014-15.
- Bakreswar Thermal Power Station and Santaldih Thermal Power Station is poised to finish FY 2020-21 at all India 8th rank and 20th rank respectively by CEA.
- WBPDCL achieved its best ever yearly SOC of 0.45 ml/kWh and APC of 8.5% in FY2020-21.
- WBPDCL achieved its best ever yearly Declared Capacity of 29,755 MU in FY2020-21 after capacity addition at Sagardighi (2X500MW).

Higher Education

- A unique Scheme, namely Student Credit Card Scheme has been started to provide hassle free bank loan up to Rs. 10 lakh at minimal interest help to the students of West Bengal from Class X up to PhD to pursue their studies.
- Academic activities of four new state aided universities, Viz. Dakshin Dinajpur University at Balurghat, Murshidabad University at Berhampur, Sadhu Ramhand Murmu University at Jhargram, Harichand Guruchand at Thakurnagar, North 24 Parganas, started during the year.
- The minimum qualifying marks in the Class X and Class XII board examination, for being considered for Swami Vivekananda Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship at Higher Secondary & Under Graduate level respectively, have been lowered down to 60 %. Previously these were was 75 %.

Food

- Ensured Food Security with adequate quantity and quality of food-grains by a robust delivery mechanism catering to about 10.44 crore people under 'Khadya Sathi' Scheme. Now, 100% distribution is made through e-PoS.
- Despite 'Covid-19' pandemic situation and 'Amphan', ensured smooth running of Public Distribution System and has been providing food grains free of cost.
- Piloting of Duare Ration Scheme started from 15.09.2021.
- Construction of Nine (09) godowns having total capacity of 94,000 MT completed during the year 2021.
- Implemented online application for all services related with digitized ration cards.
- Number of Aadhar validated Ration Cards as on date is 6.48 Crores.
- Completed Aadhar seeding of more than 2.5 crore beneficiaries in just 2 months.
- One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC) has been introduced from 1st August, 2021.

Drinking Water

- 11.65 Lakh Households have been provided with Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTC) in 2021 up to 15th November under Jalswapna Scheme.
- 1,123 nos. of Hand pump Tube wells / Rig Bored Tube wells have been sunk throughout the State to extend immediate relief to the people in the non-piped water supply scheme areas.
- 1.84 Crore drinking water pouches and 5.53 Crore liters of purified water were supplied through 1,587 water tankers, for the relief to the people affected by the Super Cyclone "YAAS".
- 5,352 Schools and Anganwadis covered by Availability of drinking water through tap connection within their premises.

Health & Family Welfare

- Under the state flagship scheme "Swasthya Sathi" every citizen except some specified categories of the state are being enrolled through Duare Sarkar, since 1st December, 2020. More than 43 lakh families have already been enrolled under the scheme.
- Number of Government Medical Colleges and Hospitals have increased from 10 to 24 and Private Medical Colleges from 1 to 6 in 2020.
- The Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) in the State has reduced considerably from 113 per 1 lakh Live Birth in 2011 to 98 in 2020 which is much below the national average of 113.
- State has achieved Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) of 22 per 1000 Live Birth, which is much below the national average of 32.

Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises

- Tantuja procured Baluchari sarees worth aprox Rs. 25 lakhs and handloom products worth Rs. 6 Cr. from weavers of the state as marketing support during the pandemic.
- Tantuja won the National Award 2018 for Design Development for Baluchari Saree.
- MANJUSHA achieved a turnover of Rs. 164.50 crores, an increase of 29.69% over the last financial year, 2019-20, the highest in the history of MANJUSHA and set-off all accumulated losses since its inception and the Board recommended dividend @Rs. 2.00/- per share.
- WBSIDCL completed Integrated Silk Park, Malda at East Block, new Industrial Estate at Khasjungle IP under RIDF-XXII.

Transport

- Massive transport arrangements were made during the period of lock-down and Covid restrictions for movement of lakhs of migrant workers/ laborers. Huge numbers of STU buses were deployed for running essential services, for movement of health workers, police and others during the lock-down period.
- Infrastructure development work of Sarsuna, Khidderpore, Basirhat, Habra Bus Stands have been completed by WBTC. Inaugaration of Kalipahari, Berhampur Bus terminus and crew rest room at Burdwan, Jhargram, Medinipur, Belghoria depot have been completed by SBSTC.
- 547 "Jalasathi" have been engaged in 481 ferry ghats for compliance of SOP by ghat operators and the ferry passengers.

Rural Development:

- A total 2178.960 km new road constructed during 20-21F.Y under Bangla Grameen Sadak Yojna.
- In the Financial Year 2020-21, West Bengal has given sanction to 8,92,272 houses. Total number of houses completed in the FY 2020-21 is 6,78,587.
- A new community cadres called "Seba Sakhi" introduced to provide support to the ailing and aged persons.

- 11 (eleven) CPUs for central level management of Solid Waste have been set up. Altogether 157 Central Processing Units (CPU) have been set up till date.
- 93,251 no. of IHHL and 92 no. of Community Sanitary Complexes were constructed.
- In current FY, 6.10 lakh new Job Cards issued.
- In Hilly region 253 Water harvesting structure completed in current Financial year
- State could complete 1031 Anganwadi Centre under convergence
- 3.5 Crore Mangrove plants planted in current Financial Year.

Women & Child Development and Social Welfare

- Lakshmir Bhandar, newly launched scheme of the State Government for the empowerment of women in the age group of 25-60 years and enrolled in 'Swasthya Sathi' provides Rs. 1000/- every month to women from SC/ST households and Rs. 500/- per month from others. Over 1.5 crore applications were received and processed.
- **Kanyashree Prakalpa:** Since inception Rs.10560 crore released and 71.1 lakh beneficiaries have been provided with the benefits.
- Rupashree Prakalpa: Since its launch in April 2018, 9.8 lakh women have received the scheme's benefit of Rs.25,000/- each, with a total of Rs.2,764.91 crore disbursed till date (September 2021). The benefit is given to indigent women to cover the expenses of their first marriage.
- Under **Manabik Pension**, persons with disability of 40% or more receive a pension of Rs. 1,000/- . Until September 2021, 4,73,494 beneficiaries have received the pension, with Rs. 284 crore released during 2021-21.
- Similarly indigent widows and senior citizens (age 60 and above) receive Rs. 1,000/- per month from the Widow Pension Scheme and Old Age Pension Scheme respectively. Till September 2021, the Widow Pension scheme has covered 7,00,564 beneficiaries, and the Old Age Pension scheme has covered 16,89,657 beneficiaries.

Agriculture

- "Krishak Bandhu' scheme was revamped and launched as Krishak Bandhu (Natun) 17th June, 2021 thereby doubling the financial assistance to the farmers to a maximum of Rs. 10,000/- and a minimum of Rs.4000/- per annum.
- Under Krishak Bandhu Death Benefit Scheme one-time grant of Rs. 2,00,000/- provided Rs.284.02 crore to 14,201 bereaved families during January to September 2021.
- "Matigantha", State Centre of Excellence for farm mechanisation training, has been inaugurated at Mati Tirtha Krishi Katha, Purba Bardhaman.
- The second tissue culture laboratory and aeroponics green house have been established at ZARS Krishnagar, Nadia and PVSM Farm, Paschim Medinpur respectively.

Urban Development

- 'MAA Programme' has been introduced under which 223 nos. of canteens were opened till now and 46 lakh people have been benefitted. Twelve lakh people (average) are being benefitted per month.
- Mohabani Development Authority (in Paschim Medinipur District) created.
- 3 new Water Supply Projects at Raiganj (25.13 mld.), Asansol (10 MGD) and Bankura (26.97 mld) made operational.
- Three new Municipalities namely, Falakata in Alipurduar District, Maynaguri at Jalpaiguri District and Bally in Howrah District created.

Minority Development

- Around 39 lakhs students were provided with the Aikyashree Scholarship which is an all-time record.
- 2600 number of eligible students provided Education Loan for pursuing professional/technical courses, amount being amounting to Rs. 29.09 cr.
- 37,755 nos. of destitute minority women provided with housing/dwelling units.
- Rs. 23.14 crore released for Construction of Boundary Wall around Graveyards.

Backward Classes Welfare

- 46,92,028 SC, ST and OBC Caste Certificates issued through online system.
- Under Taposili Bandhu pension scheme 10,13,475 persons benefitted with a financial involvement of Rs. 1037.00 Crores
- Annual Scholarship of Rs 800/- under Sikhashree disbursed to SC students of Class-V-VIII. Till date in 2021 fiscal 9,17,547 SC students benefitted and involvement stands at Rs. 73.40 Crores.
- Rs. 117.97 crores spent for 5,90,362 SC students on account of pre and post matric scholarships. Similarly, 5,51,347 students benefitted under Pre-Matric & Post-Matric OBC Scholarship till date with financial involvement of Rs. 61.86 crores.
- Under Sabooj Sathi around 16,23,365 lakh students provided bi-cycles (under Phase VI & Phase VII) in 2021 academic year.

Tribal Development Department

- Adivasi Bhawan with the facility of office accommodation, conference room, guest room, dormitory for ST(s) and Tribal Museum at Rajarhat, Newtown, Kolkata completed.
- Lepcha Bhawan with the facility of office accommodation, conference room, dormitory for Lepchas(s) and Tribal Museum for Lepcha community at Rajarhat, Newtown, Kolkata inaugurated.

Animal Resource Development

- Commenced operation of Broiler Integration Programme in and around Siliguri & Jalpaiguri.
- 6 nos. of Mother Dairy Calcutta outlet established for self- employment.
- 12604 no. of private AI workers and Pranimitra(s) received performance Incentive@ Rs. 5000/- per month during 2021.

Administrative Reforms:

- Biggest ever Integrated Administrative and Residential Complex at district level has been made functional at Nimtouri, Purba Medinipur with an overall project cost of Rs. 163 Crore (approx.).
- Office-cum-Residential Building of the Divisional Commissioner, Medinipur Division has been constructed and made functional.
- Administrative approval issued for construction of the Administrative Building of the new Paschim Bardhaman district.

Department of Information and Cultural Affairs

- 1.90 lakh folk artists enrolled under **Lok Prasar Prakalpa (LPP)** scheme and Rs. 250 crore spent for livelihood maintenance of these folk artists.
- The benefit of 'Swastha Sathi' Scheme extended to Cable TV Operators, Sub-operators, their workers and families.
- 96 retired journalists above 60 years of age and facing acute financial distress are provided with monthly pension @ Rs. 2500/- under "West Bengal Pension Scheme for the Journalists, 2018" scheme.
- 131 no. of journalists provided with medical assistance **under MAAVOI** (West Bengal Health Scheme for Journalists, 2016) a health insurance and personal accident coverage scheme for accredited journalists and their dependent family members.

- Medical Benefit Scheme for the Cine and Television Artistes/ Technicians / Workers has been introduced.
- 148 eminent aged and needy artistes Jatra artistes provided financial assistance one time pension under the scheme.

Housing

- Under CHAA SUNDARI Housing Scheme 1171 pucca houses out of 4022 approved single storied dwelling
 units in 17 sites covering 07 Tea Gardens in Alipurduar and Jalpaiguri started to provide pucca house to permanent
 tea garden workers.
- "NIJASHREE" HOUSING SCHEME: Construction of 2 sites has been completed, selection of beneficiaries of 10 (Ten) sites have been done and out of which works are going on at 7(seven) sites to provide housing among the LIG and MIG families.
- NIGHT SHELTER: Construction of 02 (Two) Night Shelters completed during 2021 and Construction is in progress at 09 (Nine) sites in various Hospitals of the state.
- Construction of two (02) "Karmanjali" are completed to provide accommodations on rental basis to the working women who are single, less paid and have no residence in the city.
- Construction of three (03) Rental Housing Estates (RHE) at Alipurduar (32 flats). Karnajora (12 flats) and Buniadpur (12 flats) completed and thirteen (13) in progress.

Land

- Pattas have been distributed among beneficiaries involving an area an area of 318.45 acre.
- Free Hold Title Deed (RR Patta): 4,974 nos. of FHTD (RR Patta) have been distributed up to 30th September, 2021.
- Automatic mutation has been launched during the year 2021 resulting significant increase of mutation cases to the tune of 51,65,000. Also, 69,400 nos. of Conversion Cases have been disposed of.
- Inter Departmental Transfer of a total of 107 cases of IDT have been sanctioned involving an area of 474.68 acres (January-September, 2021).
- Long-term Settlement of vested land in respect of 23 cases involving an area of 170.14 acres done for which the revenue amounts to Rs.13,55,87,722 (January-September, 2021) has been received.
- Under the Bon Hooghly Housing Project at Baranagar, North 24-Parganas rehabilitated 540 families who were living in an old dilapidated structure on the site and another 107 families who were residing at Uday Villa, Burma Colony, Kamarhati have also been shifted from Burma Colony and rehabilitated in the new flats at "Bonirini" at Bonhooghly Housing Project.
- During the year 2020-21 regularization of 31 refugee colonies situated in the land of State Government, Central Government and private entities have been sanctioned.

• Dredging of Muriganga river in between Kakdwip and Sagar island has been done as a result uninterrupted navigation could be achieved for almost 19 hours during the Ganga Sagar Mela, 2021.

Correctional Services

- 697 nos. of candidates selected for appointment to the post of Warder and Female Warder under the Directorate of Correctional Services, West Bengal.
- Construction work of 02(two) storied building for the accommodation of 150 inmates in Krishnanagar District Correctional Home completed.

Disaster Management

• 2 Crores people of 18 districts have been affected by Very Severe Cyclone YAAS, 26th May 2021: Damage assessed: Rs. 21535 Crores; Fund required (As per SDRF): Rs. 4522 Crores Fund received from MHA: Rs.300 Crores.

- 10.76 Lakhs people of 13 districts have been affected by Flood & Landslide in July-August 2021 due to Heavy Rain & excessive DAM Water released by DVC. Damage reported: Rs.9546 Crores.
- Under Duare Tran scheme a fund of allotted to Rs.385.50 Crores beneficiaries (Agri.-276.85 Cr.; MSMET-1.36 Cr.; ARD- 3.18 Cr. Fisheries- 29.65 Cr, HG Grant -74.45 Cr.)

Agricultural Marketing

- 18 markets of our state are functioning as e-NAM (Electronic National Agricultural Markets) markets at present and another 14 markets proposed to Government of India. More than 33000 farmers and other stakeholders have been registered online till 30.09.2021. Approximate 24,000 MT of commodities have been etraded so far.
- SUFAL BANGLA introduced in 2014 presently operates with 63 mobile vans, 3 Hubs and 350 retail outlets across the state. Daily about 75-80 MT of agricultural produces amounting to Rs. 18.00 to 20.00 lakh are sold through Sufal Bangla outlets to serve about 44,000 Consumer Families, i.e 2.00-2.50 lakh consumers daily.

Non-conventional Energy Resources

• WBREDA installed Rooftop Grid Connected Solar PV Power Plants @10kWp in 276 schools in the year 2021 and a 10 MW Solar PV Power Plant at Bhajanghat in Nadia District.

Judicial Administration

- Two Commercial Courts for Kolkata Jurisdiction, a Special Criminal Court for MLAs and MPs at Salt Lake, a family Court at Lalbag (Murshidabad), and three Fast Track Courts at Berhampore (Murshidabad) started.
- Child Friendly Courts at Howrah, Paschim Medinipur Tehatta(Nadia) Haldia, Contai completed.

Co-operation

- Crop Loan to the tune of Rs.2,580.55 crore has been disbursed to 10.09 beneficiaries against a target of Rs.2,640.00 crore to 9.05 lakh beneficiaries registering achievement to the tune of 97.75% and 111.46% respectively.
- 81,339 numbers of Self Help Groups (SHG) have been financed against a target of 42800 registering an achievement of 190.04%.
- Agriculture & Agriculture-allied and Non-Agricultural Loan of Rs.1175.51 crore has been issued against a target of Rs.931.00 crore registering 126.26% achievement.

Technical Education, Training & Skill Development

- Employers' Portal: A platform for Employers for hiring trained Candidates under Utkarsh Bangla Scheme, Polytechnic, ITI and Vocational Training Centers soft launched.
- World Skills Competition 2022: State Level Competition organised for the first time. The state winners won 5 medals (4 Gold and 1 Silver) in Regional Level Competition.

Tourism

- The Bengal Himalayan Carnival, a tree day event to boost the state's tourism industry in the wake of COVID pandemic was held in Darjeeling, Kalimpong and Gajaldoba during the first week of February, 2021.
- The Bishnupur Music Festival, a homage to the pioneers of the Bishnupur Gharana of Indian Classical Music, was organized during the first week of February, 2021.

School Education

• 100% Govt./Aided/Sponsored Schools in the State have been covered under the Mid-Day Meal programme and 112.72 lakh students have been provided with Mid-Day Meal.

Mass Education Extension & Library Services

- Library-cum-Reading Rooms are being set up in Six State Welfare Homes and one Sponsored Welfare Home.
- Bangla Sahayata Kendra(BSK) have been opened in 748 Public Libraries in state.

Science & Technology and Biotechnology

- Conducted of Technology Hunt program and financial assistance to novel and viable research projects under Technology Development and Adaptation Centre of the Department in collaboration with IIM-CIP, Joka.
- 'Vigyansathi' portal for monitoring and management of all scientific programmes of the Department launched.
- 'Junior Bigyani Kanya Medha Britti' Programme under Jagadish Ch. Bose National Science Talent Search launched.
- GIS Mapping of all Private and Government Covid Vaccination Centres (CVC) done for use of Department of Health and Family Welfare.

Fisheries

- Rs.30.01 Crore distributed to fishermen affected by "Amphan" during 2020-2021 and Rs.30.76 crore distributed to fishermen affected by "Yaas" during 2021-2022 for loss of nets, hundis, waterbodies etc.
- Old Age Pension is being disbursed to 20000 fishermen @ Rs.1000/- p/m.
- Renovation of Tapan Dighi, Dakshin Dinajpur(Project cost-Rs.36.78 Crore) and Development of Beel Balli Fisheries Project(Project cost-Rs.20.96 Crore) are under process.

- 7,845 Nos Equivalent Tanks have been Excavated/Re-excavated / Created under Jal Dharo-Jal Bharo Programme against Target of 3,819 Nos.
- 2,096 Nos Minor Irrigation Schemes (including 631 Water Detention Structures) have been Created/Revived against Target of 1,682 (including 341 Water Detention Structures) Nos.

Department of Youth Services & Sports

- 8,289 Clubs were given this year's instalment of Club Grant & 947 Coaching Camps given financial assistance.
- Fifty eminent sports personalities of the state awarded under Khel Samman Program
- Durand Cup 2021 conducted successfully in association with Indian Army.

Environment Department
