The Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, Municipal Engineering Directorate, Department of Urban Development & Municipal Affairs, Government of West Bengal on behalf of the Hon'ble Governor of West Bengal invites e-Tender from bonafide and resourceful contractors / Companies /firms / Public Sector Undertakings / Government Companies having experience in Govt. 1. In the event of e-filling, intending bidder may download the tender documents consisting of this N.I.T. Instruction to bidder (section-A), different forms & affidavits (Section-B), Special Terms & Conditions (Section-C), Specification of work (Section-D), Schedule of works (BOQ), Form-'2911(II) and Corrigenda & Addenda (if any) from the web site <http://wbtenders.gov.in> directly with the help of digital signature certificate. Necessary cost of earnest money may be remitted through online by net Banking through ICICI Bank Payment Gateway issued in favour of "Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte.", payable at Tamluk and also to be documented through e-filling the original online by net banking against Earnest Money Deposit (EMD). Intending bidder will not have to pay the cost of tender documents for the purpose of participating in e-tendering as per notification no. 199-CRC/2M-10/2012, dated 21.12.2012 of the Secretary, Public Works Department, CRC Branch, Government of West Bengal. However, the successful L1 (Lowest) bidder will have to pay the cost of Tender Documents of 2 (two) sets @ price mentioned in the list prescribed in Notification no. 452-A/PW/O/10C-35/10, dated 26.07.2011 of Secretary, Public Works Department (Accounts Branch), Government of West Bengal.

- Payment to the contractor for the work shall be made through the Director, SUDA, West Bengal. Engineer-in-Charge (Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, MED) of the work will submit the 'passed for payment' Bill to the Director, SUDA, West Bengal.
- Sites of work as mentioned in the above table may change, if necessary, within the area of ULB concerned.
- Bidder intending to participate in more than one work shall have to furnish credential for summation of amount put to tender for those works of cumulative amount.
- Intending bidder shall have to apply separately for each work of this NIT. **Bidders are requested to upload the files of relevant work(s) for which he intend to participate.**
- A bidder desirous of taking part in a tender shall login to the e-Procurement Portal of the Government of West Bengal <https://wbtenders.gov.in> using his login ID and Password and thereafter may download the tender document consisting of this N.I.T., Instruction to Bidders (Section - A), different Forms & Affidavits (Section - B), Special Terms & Conditions (Section-C), Specification of Work (Section - D), Additional Terms & Conditions and specification for Electrical works (Section -E)& Schedule of Works (BOQ), W.B. Form No. 2911(ii) and Addenda & Corrigenda (if any) from the website directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate.

2. Both Technical Bid & Financial Bid are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed in the Website <http://wbtenders.gov.in>

3. Tender documents may be downloaded from website and submission of Technical Bid & Financial

Bid will be done as per time schedule.

4. The FINANCIAL OFFER of the prospective bidder will be consider only if the TECHNICAL BID of the bidder is found qualified after Technical Evaluation by the Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte. The decision of the Executive Engineer will be final and absolute in this respect. The list of qualified bidder will be displayed in the website.

5. **Eligibility criteria for participation in the tender:**

- i. The prospective bidder shall have satisfactorily completed at least in a single same nature of work during the last 5 (five) years from the date of issue of this notice and having a magnitude of **40%** (Forty percent) of the amount put to tender. **OR** [Non-statutory document]
- ii. Intending bidders should produce credentials of 2(two) similar nature of works, each of the minimum value of 30% of the estimated amount put to tender during the last 5 (five) years from the date of issue of this notice. **OR** [Non-statutory document]
- iii. Intending bidders should produce credentials of one single running work of similar nature which has been completed to the extent of 80% or more and value of which is not less than the desired value at (i) above. **N.B.:** Estimated amount, Date of completion of project and detail communicational address of client must be indicated in the Credential Certificate.
- iv. In case of running works, only those bidders who will submit the satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executed agency i.e. the bidder.

AND

- v. **Bank Solvency for Rs. 15.00 Lakh in the form of solvency certificate issued from any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank after the date of publication of this NleT is to be furnished.**

AND

- vi. **Annual Turnover :- Rs. 37.00 Lakh in any year of the last five financial year.**

AND

- vii. **The available Bid capacity (to be calculated on the basis of prescribed format) of the prospective applicant shall not be less than that of the quoted amount as per Annexure-A in terms of memorandum no- 45-W(C)/1M- 23/15 Dated- 13.02.2015 of Principal Secretary Public works Department, works Branch, Govt. of West Bengal (If applied for more than one works).**

AND

- viii. The prospective tenderer shall have in their full time engagement experienced technical personal - **One Civil Engineer (Minimum qualification Diploma in Civil Engineering). Self declaration of the Engineer in the annexed format is to be furnished.** (Authenticated documents in respect of qualification and engagement shall be furnished for Technical Evaluation)

AND

- ix. The tenderer should submit the list of machinery related with this work. Necessary requirement of principal machineries which must be possessed either owned or leased by the tenderer. Other modern machinery required for the work to be executed by Mechanical means as far as practicable. Necessary certificate should be submitted for authenticity of own / leased machineries. Minimum requirement of machineries as follows:-

(a) Tilting Drum Mixer of suitable capacity-1 No.

(b) Internal or immersion Vibrator- 2 Nos.

N.B: Original documents in support of own possession / arrange through lease hold registered agreement of the aforesaid machineries is to be furnished if required by the Tender Inviting Authority

AND

- x. Income Tax Return Receipt for the Last Five Assessment years, copy of up-to-date P.T. Deposited Challan, GST Registration Certificate, up to date P. Tax clearance Certificates, PAN Card, Valid Trade License, PF & ESI Certificate etc and any other(s), if applicable, to be accompanied with the Technical Bid document.

Note

Intending Bidder(s) has/have liberty to apply for more than one serial/all Serials as specified above. However, in that case, his/her/their eligibility criteria will be evaluated in the following manner;

1. **Turn Over:** According to numbers of serial prayed by the Bidder, minimum Turn Over required against each serial number as specified under Annexure A will be added cumulatively. If total

minimum Turnover so calculated is less than or equal to maximum turnover so achieved by the Bidder during last five years then the Bidder will be eligible for those serials under the criteria of "Minimum Turnover".

2. **Bank Solvency:** According to numbers of serial prayed by the Bidder, minimum Bank Solvency required against each serial number as specified under Annexure A will be added cumulatively. If total minimum Bank Solvency so calculated is less than or equal to maximum Bank Solvency submitted by the Bidder then the Bidder will be eligible for those serials under the criteria of "Minimum Bank Solvency". Bank Solvency Certificate issued prior date of publication of Tender will not be considered as valid document.

3. **Credentials:** Cumulative in nature

4. **Bid Capacity:** Available bid capacity should be equal or more than estimated amount put to tender (cumulative).

5. **Plants & machineries:** Should have multiple (equals to the nos. of works applied) sets of plants & machineries.

6. **Technical Personnel:-** Minimum 2 Nos.(Minimum qualification Diploma in Civil Engineering).

Other terms and conditions of the credentials:

6. Payment certificate will not be treated as credential;
7. Credential certificate issued by the Executive Engineer or equivalent or competent authority of a State / Central Government, State / Central Government undertaking, Statutory / Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central / State statute, on the executed value of completed / running work will be taken as credential.
8. No credential will be considered as valid unless it is supported by **work order, price schedule or BOQ of work** and completion certificate mentioning the date of completion issued by the competent authority not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent or competent authority of a State / Central Government, State / Central Government undertakings, Statutory / Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central / State Statute. The completion certificate should indicate the value of the work (equal to booked expenditure).
9. N.B. The credential certificate for completed works should contain (a) Name of work (b) Estimated Amount (c) Tendered amount, (d) Value of executed work (e) Date of Completion of project (f) NIT No. with Tender ID and along with telephone number & detail address for communication of client must be indicated in the Credential Certificate. *[Non Statutory Documents]*

The prospective bidder shall have in their experienced technical personal. (Authenticated documents in respect of qualification and engagement shall be furnished for Technical Evaluation)

[Non-statutory documents]

Income Tax Return Receipt for the Last Five Assessment years, copy of up-to-date P.T. Deposited Challan, GST Registration Certificate, up to date GST clearance Certificates, up to date P. Tax clearance Certificates, PAN Card, Valid Trade License etc. and any other(s), if applicable, to be accompanied with the Technical Bid document. ***For Electrical works license etc. will have to be submitted as per Section-C of this NIT.***

[Non-statutory documents]

The prospective bidders or any of their constituent partner (s) shall neither have abandoned any work nor any of their contract have been rescinded during the last 3 (three) years. Such abandonment or rescission will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect through affidavit has to be furnished by the prospective bidder without which the Technical Bid shall be treated as non-responsive) Neither prospective bidder nor any of constituent partner(s) should have been debarred to participate in tender(s) by the any Department, Government of West Bengal during the last 2 (two) years prior to the date of this NIT. Such

debarment will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders as per prescribed format without which the Technical Bid shall be treated non-responsive).

In case of Proprietorship and Partnership Firms and Company the Tax Audited Report in 3CB Form to be furnished along with Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account and all schedules forming the part of Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account. Tax Audited Report, Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account including all schedules forming the part of Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account should be in favour of applicant.

[Non-statutory documents]

The prospective bidder should own or arrange through lease hold registered agreement, the required plant and machineries. Conclusive proof of ownership in favour of owner, leaser of plant & machineries in working condition shall have to be submitted.

[Non-statutory documents]

Register partnership deed for partnership firm is to be submitted. The company shall furnish the Article of Association and Memorandum. Where an individual person holds a digital certificate in his own name duly issued to him against the company or the firm of which he happens to be a director or partner, such individual person shall while uploading any tender for and on behalf of such company or firm, invariably upload a copy of registered power of attorney showing clear authorization in his favour, by the rest of the directors of such company or the partners or such firm to upload such tender.

[Non-statutory documents]

10. Registered Unemployed Engineers' Co-operative Societies / Unemployed Labour Co-operative Societies are required to furnish valid Bye Law, Current Audit Report, Certificate of Registration and Valid Clearance Certificate from A.R.C.S. Valid Professional Tax Deposit Challan, PAN Card, EPF, ESI, Valid 15-digit Goods & Service Tax Payer Identification Number (GSTIN) under GST Act, 2017 with relevant document with up-to-date return along with other relevant supporting papers.
11. Joint Ventures will not be allowed.
12. **As per memorandum no. 311-W(c)/1M-132/15 dated.28.03.2018 of PWD, for building works worth value less than Rs. 25 crore & which are predominantly Civil work in nature with electrical components less than 25% of the estimated amount put to tender, the Civil contractor is allowed to submit an agreement in non-judicial stamp paper of requisite value with an electrical contractor for execution of the electrical components of the work. In that case the electrical contractor will have to qualify for all requirements set forth in the NIEt for electrical works including credential, electrical supervisor's certificate of competency (SCC) etc. The Civil contractor will have to qualify for all requirements set forth in the NIEt including requisite credential for Civil component of such works but excluding credential and SCC requirements for electrical works. However, the onus and full responsibility of execution of the total work (Civil & Electrical) will be on the civil contractor who will execute the agreement with the Department. Payment will also be made to the civil contractor only.**

A prospective bidder shall be allowed to participate in a particular job either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have an applied severally in a single job, all his applications will be rejected for that job without assigning any reason thereof.

13. A partnership firm will have to furnish the registered partnership deed and a company will have to furnish the Article of Association and Memorandum.

[Non Statutory Documents]

14. Where an individual person holds a digital certificate in his / her own name duly issued to him / her against the company or the firm of which he / she happens to be a director or partner, such individual person shall, while uploading any tender for and on behalf of such company or firm, invariably upload a copy of registered power of attorney showing clear authorization in his / her favour, by the rest of the directors of such company or the partner of such firm, to upload such tender. The power of

attorney shall have to be registered in accordance with the provision of the Registration Act, 1908 as per G.O. no. 61/SPW/12 dated 08/06/2012.

15. Partnership Firm, Company Limited Firm, Private Company Limited Firm shall be registered by the respective competent authority from the Registrar of Firms, Society, Non-Trading Corporation, Registrar of Companies etc. & copy of Registration Certificate (*with allotment of Registration No.*) will have to be submitted, otherwise the Technical Bid will not be considered for qualification & Financial Bid shall not be opened.

The payment will be made as and when fund is available from the concerned source. No claim whatsoever for delay in payment, if any, will be entertained. Retention money towards Security deposit will be deducted from the running account bill as per prevailing Govt. order. No interest will be paid on security deposit.

Constructional Labour Welfare CESS @ 1% (one percent) of cost of construction will be deducted from the bill(s) of the contractor(s) on all contracts awarded on or after 01/11/2006 in pursuance with G.O. no. 599A/4M-28/06 dated 27/09/2006. GST, Royalty & all other Statutory levy / CESS will have to be borne by the contractor & the schedule of rates are inclusive of all the taxes & CESS stated above as per rule.

Successful bidders will be required to observe the following conditions strictly:

Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and Employees State Insurance Act, 1948 should be strictly adhered to wherever such Acts become applicable.

Minimum wages to the workers shall be paid according to the rates notified and / or revised by the State Government from time-to-time under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 in respect of scheduled employments, within the specified time as per law. Payment of bonus, wherever applicable, has to be made.

Adequate safety and welfare measures must be provided as per the provisions of the Building and other Construction Workers' (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 read with West Bengal Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2004.

All liabilities arising out of engagement of workers are duly met before submission of bills for payment.

If there is any violation of any or all the relevant above criteria during execution of the job, it will render the concerned agencies ineligible for the work then and there or at any subsequent stage as may be found convenient.

No Mobilisation Advance and Secured Advance will be allowed. Agencies shall have to arrange required land for installation of Machineries, (specified for each awarded work, storing of materials, labour shed etc. at their own cost and responsibility nearest to the work site. Bids shall remain valid for a period not less than 120 (*one hundred twenty*) days from the last date of submission of Financial Bid / Sealed Bid. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the period of bid validity the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited without assigning any reason thereof. In case of inadvertent typographical mistake found in the specified schedule of rates / BOQ, the same will be treated to be so corrected as to conform with the relevant schedule of rates prevailing at the time of floating of tender and / or technically sanctioned estimate. No claim whatsoever for such inadvertent typographical mistake will be entertained.

All materials required for the proposed scheme as mentioned including cement & steel will have be of specified grade & approved brand in conformity with relevant code of practice (*latest revision*) & manufactured accordingly & will have to be procured & supplied by the agency at his/her own cost including all taxes.

Adjustment of Price (increase or decrease) Vide Notification No.23-CRC/2M-61/2008, Dated:13.03.2009 & Notification No. 38-CRC/2M-61/2008 Dated 20.04.2009 shall not be applicable. Since B.O.Q for the works under this N.I.T. the bidder shall quote their rate (percentage above / below / at per) accordingly considering that no escalation and / or price adjustment will be allowed by the department there to under any circumstances.

Agencies shall have to arrange required land for installation of Plant & Machineries, (specified for each awarded work, shoring of materials, labour shed, laboratory etc at their own cost and responsibility nearest to the work site.

Agencies shall have to arrange land for erection of Plant & Machineries storing of materials, labour shed, laboratories etc at their own cost and responsibility.

All materials required for execution of each work (as per BOQ) to be produced and supplied at site by the contractor at his own cost.

There shall be no provision of arbitration (vide notification no. 558/SPW dt. 13.12.2011 of Secretary, to the government of West Bengal).

The Bidder, at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice inviting Tender, the cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense. Issuance of letter of acceptance / Work Order may be delayed and / or work may be financially restricted upto the limit of existing administrative approval until receipt of administrative approval / revised administrative approval from the competent authority (*in applicable cases*). Also issuance of letter of acceptance / work Order may be delayed and / or work may be restricted in some stretches till necessary land for the same is made available and / or encroachments are removed (*in applicable cases*). No claim, whatsoever, for such delay in issuance of Letter of Acceptance / Work Order and / or restriction of work will be entertained. Intending bidders may keep these criteria in mind while participating in tender and / or while quoting their rates.

Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in 'Instructions to Bidders' before bidding.

Defect Liability Period:- As per Notification No. 5784-PW/L&A/2M-175/2017 dt. 12.09.2017 of Principal Secretary, PWD and relevant clause of Form no. 2911.

For this work defect liability period is 5 years from the date of completion of the work as per completion certificate issued by the concerned Executive Engineer, MED. However, completion certificate should be issued after completion of all items of works as per schedule as required including supplementary items (if any) in all respect.

Acceptance of Bid: The "Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte" will accept the Bid. He / She does not bind himself / herself to accept otherwise the lowest Bid and reserves to himself / herself the right to reject any or all of the Bids received without assigning any reason thereof.

Escalation of Cost: There will be no escalation in cost for materials or labour and the contract price mentioned in the contract stands valid till completion of the contract, and other obligation, if any.

Execution of Work: The Contractor is liable to execute the whole work as per direction and instruction of the Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte.

Influence: Any attempt to exercise undue influence in the matter of acceptance of Bid is strictly prohibited and any Bidder who resorts to this will render his Bid liable to rejection.

Earnest Money: The amount of earnest money @ 2% (two percent) of the Estimated Amount put to tender in the shape of online by net Banking through ICICI Bank Payment Gateway drawn in favour of "Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte." payable at Tamluk against the work. This clause is also applicable for all categories of applicants except those are exempted as per prevailing Government Order. Total EMD to be paid through online (any of the banks listed in the ICICI bank payment Gateway) In case of payment through ICICI bank payment Gateway, ICICI bank through online will also be valid as per Memorandum No.3975-F(Y) dated-28/07/2016 of Finance Department, Govt. of WB. Retention money towards performance security amounting to 8% of the value of work shall be deducted from the running account bill.

The bidder at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender, the cost of visiting the site shall be at the Bidder's own expense.

17. The intending bidder shall clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids no cost of binding shall be reimbursable. The Executive Engineer, Executive Engineer reserves the right to reject any application for purchasing Bid documents and to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have incurred by any Bidder at the stage of bidding.

18. Prospective applicants are advised to note carefully the minimum qualification criteria as mentioned in Instructions to Bidder before bidding.

19. In case of Ascertaining Authority at any stage of tender process or execution of work necessary registered irrevocable power of attorney is to be produced.

All intending bidder are requested to be present in the chamber of the Executive Engineer, East Midnapore Division, M.E.Dte. during opening of the tender to observe the tender opening procedure.

20. CONDITIONAL and INCOMPLETE TENDER will not be accepted under any circumstances.

21. Plant and Machineries :-

Plant Machineries and equipments shall be owned or arranged through lease hold agreements by the bidders. Conclusive proof of ownership (Tax invoice, way bill, delivery challan) for each plant and machinery in working condition shall have to be submitted. [Non-statutory documents]

SECTION – A

1. General guidance for e-tendering

Instructions/ Guidelines for bidders for electronic submission of the tenders have been annexed for assisting them to participate in e-tendering.

2. Registration of Bidder

Any bidder willing to take part in the process of e-tendering will have to be enrolled and registered with the Government e-procurement system, through logging on to <https://wbenders.gov.in>. The bidder is to click on the link for e-tendering site as given on the web portal.

3. Digital Signature certificate (DSC)

Each bidder is required to obtain a class-II or Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders, from the service provider of the National Information's Centre (NIC) or any other bonafide service provider on payment of requisite amount. Details are available at the Web Site stated in Clause 2 of Guideline to bidder. DSC is given as a USB e-Token.

The contractor can search and download NIeT, tender Documents and Addenda & Corrigenda (if any) electronically from computer once he/she logs on to the website mentioned in Clause 2 using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of tender Documents.

Penalty for suppression / distortion of facts:

REJECTION OF BID

D. 1.1.2. The supervisor deployed by the contractor should have valid Electrical SCC Part No. 1, 2, 4, 7A & 11 issued by the West Bengal Licensing Board, Government of West Bengal.

D. 1.2. The contractor shall have to meet the following requirements:

D. 1.2.1. The contractor shall have valid Electrical Contractor's License issued by the West Bengal Licensing Board, Government of West Bengal.
